Administrative and Biographical Sketch

The Superintendents were representatives of the national Board of Home Missions and worked in the various Conferences across Canada. Their duties included--in cooperation with the Presbyteries--the supervision of all aid-receiving missions and charges, the oversight of an annual fund raising campaign, and the organization of new pastoral charges and mission fields. In British Columbia, there was an emphasis on work with Native Indians, Japanese Canadians, and on the coastal marine missions and hospital work.

Since the time of Union, B.C. Conference had been the largest consumer of Home Missions grants allocated to Conferences and had maintained a proportionately large staff. Immediately following Union, there were three Superintendents at work in B.C., but with the severe cutbacks that followed the Depression this was reduced to two in the 1930s and to one by 1939, William Percy Bunt, who served until his retirement in 1958.

Bunt was born in Markdale, Ontario in 1888, and was educated at McGill University and Wesleyan Theological College in Montreal. In 1920, he was ordained as a Methodist minister in Vancouver. As Superintendent, he was especially active on behalf of Japanese Canadians during the Second World War.

Scope and Contents Note

This inventory has been divided into two parts. The first part describes Bunt's records which relate to Japanese Canadians, primarily during the period of the Second World War when many Japanese Canadians--including members of the United Church--were forced to live in internment camps. Most of the files are made up of correspondence, and have been arranged in four series, beginning with a General Administration series which contains the following: correspondence between Bunt and Japanese Canadian ministers, the Board of Home Missions, and the B.C. Security Commission; files on various committees and conferences concerned with the Japanese situation; and other miscellaneous files, including newspaper clippings and pamphlets. The second series, Internment Camps and Other Relocation Sites, is made up of correspondence between Bunt and Japanese Canadian ministers and other individuals who lived and worked in the camps. Series three, Files Dealing With Former Japanese Property, contains information on what happened to the property--including church property--which had been confiscated from the Japanese. The final series, Other Correspondence from Japanese, consists of files which do not fit well into any of the other series. The date range of the records on Japanese Canadians is from 1936 to 1965, but most of the files do not post-date 1949.

The second part of the inventory describes the remainder of Bunt's records, which have been divided into three series. The first series deals with hospitals which were administered by the United Church, the second series contains files for various places and properties in B.C., and the final series is made up of general files, including two informative files on Indian work and interdenominational activities. The date range of the records described in the second part of the inventory is from 1928 to 1957, but most of the files are from the 1950s.

Those files which predate Bunt's appointment as Superintendent may have been his own personal files or may have been transferred to him by his predecessors or by the national office.

Finally, a preliminary inventory, containing item lists for some of the files, was in use before this present inventory was compiled. These item lists have been photocopied and are found in this inventory beginning on page 10.
