Biographical Sketch

Henderson was born in 1918 and was ordained in B.C. Conference in 1943. After serving several pastoral positions in B.C., he was appointed Superintendent of Home Missions in 1958. His term was very brief, however, as he was appointed the first Executive Secretary of B.C. Conference in 1963 and remained in that office until 1966. Henderson held several other positions in the church before his retirement in 1980.
