4. Regarding the Vocational Assessment you completed with Elliott Clarke & Associates, provide a reflection regarding your assessment and how it has shaped your learning goals for your educational program.
5. Reflect on your experience of the practice of ministry over the last few years, including your current work with the Pastoral Charge (*if applicable*) you are appointed to. What have you learned? What area for further growth are you aware of?
6. What else would you like CAB to know about your candidacy process/formation for ministry?
